Footnotes

SHAKIN SHAMUS was bumped at the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and held on to a diminishing margin. IPPON was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter and was gaining on the winner late. WAR OF ATTRITION was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and lacked the needed closing response. COOKIN N BOOKIN raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. TWILIGHT MEMO was never far back while racing along the inside and lacked the needed closing response. TOTALLY YOU was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and did not threaten. GOLDEN BOY MARK was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. RASPAROV showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and was not a factor.
