Footnotes

SWISS EXPLOIT was never far back while racing along the inside, moved up to engage CASTLE PINES into the lane and edged away from that rival through the closing yards. CASTLE PINES pressed the pace from the inside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-sixteenth marker but could not match strides with the winner late. LAST TIME AROUND chased the leaders from the far outside throughout and finished willingly. ROYAL MANGO was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside and finished with a belated bid. TOM BOMBADIL pressed the pace from between foes and gave way in the drive. PRIVATE JETTZ was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear margin nearing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way after going a half. TRAVELIN JEFF lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. PERFECT KIVA was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. LOBOS ROAR bobbled at the break and lagged throughout.
