BLACKJACK MOON was away alertly to duel for the lead from between foes, opened a clear margin nearing the quarter and was ridden out to the wire to be kept to task. RISKY ORBIT broke sharply to press the pace of the winner from the outside, was no match for that winner in the drive but clearly second best. SNORT SNORT was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, moved between foes in mid-stretch and finished evenly late. SONAR EXPRESS bobbled at the break and was bumped, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a belated bid. WINSOME BUCKS veered in at the break, moved up quickly to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened after going a half. PRINCE BUSTER raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and failed to rally. LOTTA PROMISE was bumped at the start, lagged far back early and did not reach contention. BABY FACE COP broke out, chased the leaders from off the rail and stopped after going a half.
