Footnotes

PARIS ISLAND set a pressured pace from between foes, opened a clear lead into the lane and steadily drew off. HOLLYWOOD BRASS was never far back, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good energy. SHOOTING SEQUENCE was pinched back at the start, moved up quickly to press the pace from the inside and gave way in the drive. BENSON ROAD showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and finished with good late speed. HERE COMES LUCKY pressed the pace from the outside and gave way after going a half. HIGH WATER BAY lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. EX TREMELY COOL was void of early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and was not a factor.
