Footnotes

JANUARY'S LADY was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command with a quarter to run and steadily drew clear. SICILY GRACE was never far back, raced wide through the turn, could not reach the winner in the drive but finished willingly. DAVESNOTHERE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further into the stretch, reached a striking position in mid-stretch but failed to gain late. MISSIS CALDWELL set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way gradually after going a half. POSTESS was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside and also gave way after a half. LADY SCHNAPPS raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and gradually weakened. ANGEL'S KEEP was void of early foot, raced far wide through the turn and did not menace. KOOKIE GAME hopped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
