MO'S FLASHY DATE was off a step slow, rushed to contention, raced wide through the turn, gained command nearing the sixteenth pole and quickly drew off. THUNDER THORN was never far back, raced off the rail into the stretch and finished with a steady bid. SHAKALAKA was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the outside, moved inside in mid-stretch and finished willingly. BROULEE BEACH was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear margin nearing the five-sixteenths marker and gave way late. RED SEA showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and found his best stride late. MR. ICHIBAN lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. EIGHTY EIGHT raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and gradually weakened. SHAKIN SHAMUS was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, angled out nearing the quarter and failed to menace. CAUTIOUS AFFAIR raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and gradually weakened. BE THERE JOE was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and weakened after going a half.
