HIT THE JUICE was bumped at the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, turned back the tandem bids from BUCKLE and KUYA into the lane and gamely held to the wire. BUCKLE was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage the winner in mid-stretch but could not get by that rival in the drive. SECRET ELEMENT raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. EZINMOTION was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a late rally. KUYA was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-sixteenth pole and gave way through the final sixteenth. AT THE BADA BING was never far back while racing along the inside and lacked the needed closing response. COURT MISCHIEF was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. OUR TAIL WIN showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and failed to menace.
