Footnotes

BIJOU BARRISTER lacked early speed, began to work his way forward from the outside nearing the three-eighths marker, responded to steady urging and caught OLYMPIC LIGHTS through the final yards to be drawing clear late. OLYMPIC LIGHTS stalked the pace of CLASSIELYTE from the outside, moved up to take command with a furlong to run, opened a clear lead but could not resist the winner late. OVERTIME VICTORY was off a step slow, raced wide through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with good energy. CARRY ON JOHN was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside throughout and gave way in the drive. INHOC SIGNO VINCAS raced off the leaders from the inside, moved up to offer a bid in mid-stretch and failed to sustain his rally. CLASSIELYTE went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened after going three-quarters. WASSERMAN broke sharply to race forwardly placed early, moved outside through the second turn and weakened in the drive. ONE QUICK BREW lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and failed to menace. STEALTH ATTACK was void of early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten.
