GO ALL IN raced off the leaders from the inside early, split foes in mid-stretch and proved best over CHEROKEE COLE through a stiff drive. CHEROKEE COLE lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane, moved up to gain a slight edge in mid-stretch but could not match strides with the winner through the final furlong. PERKY MOMENTS was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way in the drive. SKIPPYJON JONES chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-sixteenths pole and failed to sustain his rally. TRIP THE WIRE showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and finished with some late run. WEGOTA REPUBLICAN raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and finished evenly. GAVIN SLEW was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not threaten. DIXIEDOODLEDEUDE chased the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. PAROXYSM was hustled along to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going five furlongs.
