BRAINSTORM lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, moved up to take command inside the furlong marker and steadily drew clear. CHICKASAW PARK broke in the air, raced far wide through the turn and finished full of run. TIJUANA TUESDAY broke sharply to set a pressured pace from off the rail and gave way grudgingly in the drive. D DEVIL chased the leaders from the inside and gradually gave way. R SAMURAI lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly. NEW YORK BABY broke sharply to press the pace from the outside and gave way after going a half. TOM BOMBADIL chased the leaders from the far outside and also weakened after a half. ALBIHIGHWAY was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace.
