Footnotes

SAINTLY I AIN'T steadied soon after the start, raced off the pacesetters, moved up from the outside to take command nearing the quarter and drew off through the lane. STORM ABOVE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to gain the place. KID HUEY was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good energy. HIT THE JUICE was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from between rivals, moved outside through the turn and failed to rally when called upon. PETE'S BLACK GOLD showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and found his best stride late. REASON TO RECKON raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and did not menace. MR. THIMBLE chased the leaders from off the rail throughout and lacked the needed closing response. DICEY DEAL raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened. HE'S THE PITZ bobbed at the start, lacked early speed, raced removed from the rail and failed to threaten. TRIESTE'D N TRUE was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened after going a half. GOLD COUNTRY was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and stopped suddenly after going five-eighths.
