STOMPEN' STANLEY broke in air then was allowed to settle, raced wide through the turn, reached the fore with a sixteenth to run and quickly drew off. COMPETITIVE SPORT was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside and finished with a steady rally. LARI'S LIL LARRY was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths marker, opened a clear margin and gave way through the final sixteenth. REMARKABLE LEGEND was hustled along to open a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after going a half. HAYSEEEED HENRY was never far back, raced far wide through the turn and gradually weakened. FLASHY HALO lacked early foot, angled inside nearing the quarter and failed to menace. HERE COMES THE COP showed brief speed from the far outside and weakened.
