HAVIN A GOOD DAY sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, was well rated into the lane and drew off when asked. FORMULA GOLD was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the quarter and failed to gain on the winner in the drive. SHAKEREADYNROLL chased the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed late response. OVER AND UNDER lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. AWESOME TOCCET showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and failed to menace. COLONEL COURTNEY chased the leaders from off the rail and weakened after going three-quarters. PROUD ILLUSION lacked early foot, raced between foes through the back-stretch, moved outside through the second turn and did not reach contention. OUR TAIL WIN raced off the pacesetters from the inside and gradually weakened.
