REAL HEART stalked the leaders from the far outside, moved up to take command into the lane, quickly drew off and was in hand to the wire. GOLD HARBOR was away alertly to press the pace of the winner from the outside, was no match for that rival in the drive but held gamely for the place. MOBIL SUPREME raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a late bid. PADDY'S POT'O GOLD raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and lacked the needed closing response. STICKY CANDY broke sharply to set a pressured pace from off the rail and weakened after going a half. AKICKATTHEKAT lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled inside nearing the sixteenth pole and did not reach contention. POLITICAL HAZE was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. FREEDOM HALL showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and failed to offer a bid.
