GENERAL CUSTER was off a step slow then hustled along to duel for the lead from the inside, drifted out through the lane and held on to a diminishing margin. OUR TAIL WIN was never far back, raced wide through the turn, was carried out by the winner through the lane and just missed. JANUARY GOLD showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good late energy. FUZZY PITCH lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. NOOK HAVEN was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and weakened after going a half. SHAMELESS EXPENSE raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened.
