Footnotes

CASTLE PINES tracked the early leaders, moved up to offer a bid from four wide nearing the quarter pole and wore down KINDACATCHY in the final yards. KINDACATCHY stalked the early pace, moved up to challenge for the lead near the quarter pole from between foes, grabbed the lead in the upper stretch and continued on gamely to the wire to lose a close one. HE'S ALWAYS RIGHT was in the second flight early, swung out four wide coming into the stretch and finished well to complete the trifecta. FATMANSTEW stumbled at the start, quickly recovered and moved up into contention but lacked the needed late response and tired. SEYAH ATTHE KAZBA raced in the second flight early, moved out to the four path coming into the stretch but failed to threaten. JUNIOR CRUISER set the early pace while racing in hand, remained in the fray until the upper stretch then came up empty and tired. BULLET TRAIN was outrun.
