PROMISCUOUS LAD was never far back, raced wide through the second turn, moved between rivals with a sixteenth to run and proved best over BRICKYARDTRADITION in a game effort. BRICKYARDTRADITION raced off the leaders early, angled out nearing the quarter, moved up to offer a bid nearing the sixteenth pole but could not get by the winner late. GETRDONEGOTRDID dueled for the lead from the inside, opened a clear lead nearing the half and gave way to the top two through the final yards. CABALLITO DE MAR lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. BALLERINA'S BEAU showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with some late run. TOUGH GOLD raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened. TAYLOR JONES hopped at the start, raced just off the leaders, angled out nearing the quarter and weakened through the lane. PRIVATE JETTZ was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and weakened after going five furlongs.
