Footnotes

NATIVE CHUM dueled for the early advantage from the inside, opened a clear margin nearing the quarter, drifted inward at the sixteenth pole and held sway to the wire. WILD W B T was never far back while racing from off the rail, checked when the winner came in nearing the sixteenth marker, recovered quickly and finished with good energy. MINISTER MAN broke sharply to duel for the lead from between foes, raced wide through the turn and finished with good courage in the drive. SOUTH CARSON was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, dropped back nearing the quarter, angled outside and finished with a late rally. HECKA FAST pressed the pace from the far outside for a half and gave way. POINT DANGER veered out early, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. MINING FOR CRYSTAL lacked early foot, raced extremely wide through the turn and did not offer a bid. YOU CAN WIN showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and was not a factor. The rider of WILD W B T lodged an objection against NATIVE CHUM concerning the checking of her mount at the sixteenth pole and after reviewing the films the stewards made no change.
