FIRE DANCERS M G was bumped at the start, dueled for the early advantage from the outside, opened a clear margin nearing the quarter and steadily drew off. CRYPTIC RIVER was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside and finished with a steady rally. SEETHATHARBOR raced off the pacesetters from the outside throughout and finished evenly late. TRIBAL RYTHUM showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. ONE COOL GUY was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the outside, drifted out nearing the quarter and gradually gave way. SOARING LIKE EAGLE chased the leaders from the far outside for three furlongs and weakened. COUGAR BOB showed brief speed and weakened. ZION'S VIEW was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor.
