CHICKS DIG HIM stalked the leaders from the inside throughout, moved up to take command into the lane and held gamely to the wire. BAD AS CAN BE lagged early, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with a steady rally. SWISS EXPLOIT pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to engage nearing the quarter and finished with good courage. PERUSETHENews broke sharply to race off the leaders from the outside, angled in through the final yards and finished with good energy. HAVIN A GOOD DAY sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and gave way gradually after going three-quarters.
