**Footnotes**

AMADREAMER stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage SHINTARO into the lane and proved best over that rival through a prolonged drive. SHINTARO went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, met the bid of the winner nearing the three-sixteenths pole but gave way grudgingly to that rival through the final yards. IS THE BAR CLOSED raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. SOCKS ON SOCKS OFF was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside and finished evenly in the drive. OLD MUSKET was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. DR. BOB was void of early speed, raced off the rail throughout and failed to menace. BEAU RIALTO was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. NICK'S GOLD was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened. DEVIL FROM DIXIE chased the leaders from the inside for the opening quarter and weakened. DIXIEDOODLEDEUDE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not offer a bid. MAJOR FIB was never far back while racing from between foes and gradually weakened.
