TEKELA RESERVE dueled for the lead from the outside with J J'S GYPSY, vied with that rival into deep stretch and edged ahead in the drive. J J'S GYPSY was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the outside with the winner and could not get by that rival through a prolonged drive. LET'S TOP IT OFF was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from off the rail, dropped back nearing the three-eighths marker, responded to steady urging and came back to finish full of run, belatedly. CURVITUDE was away alertly then dropped off the leaders, moved far outside through the turn, reached a contending position into the stretch but lacked the needed closing response. KODAROO was never far back, raced wide through the turn and gradually weakened. AVANT GARDE hopped at the start, saved ground throughout and did not threaten.
