Footnotes

CAT VON DIVA pressed the pace from the far outside, responded when set down for the drive, reached LET'S CELEBRATE inside the furlong marker and drew clear through the final yards. LET'S CELEBRATE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, moved up to take command nearing the three-sixteenths pole and yielded to the winner late. WILD CHICA broke sharply to press the pace from the outside, was carried out by BONNIE VAILLE nearing the five-sixteenths pole, angled inside that rival and finished with good courage. CHURCHBELLSRINGING lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. BONNIE VAILLE was away alertly then hustled along to set a pressured pace, drifted out nearing the five-sixteenths marker and failed to menace thereafter. PRINCESS LOU broke in the air, was allowed to settle, bumped with DULCINEA LA ROSA into the lane and did not reach contention. DULCINEA LA ROSA raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, bumped with PRINCESS LOU nearing the quarter and did not threaten. COLORFUL TUNE chased the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened.
