C. R. FESS was away alertly to press the pace of MISS LAUREL LU from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths pole and drew off through the lane. LITTLE M C chased the leaders from the inside throughout and failed to gain on the winner in the drive. A P JANNY lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with good energy. MINDBOGLER was never far back, raced wide through the turn, angled out further approaching the stretch and finished evenly late. MISS LAUREL LU set a pressured pace for three furlongs and gave way. MARY'S ANGEL ANNIE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to rally. GO OCHO GO was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. MY GINNY N TONIC raced off the leaders from the far outside and gradually weakened.
