RUN INDY RUN was away alertly to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the three-eighths marker and was ridden out through the lane while much the best. NEW GIRL was bumped at the start, pressed the pace of the winner from the inside, was no match for that rival in the drive but held on well to save the place. LET'S CELEBRATE was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from between foes and finished willingly. SAINTLY ROAR was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the inside throughout and failed to gain in the drive. DIVA G. was off slow, bumped and steadied, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. BAHATI GOLD lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not menace. KEEPERROCKIN raced off the leaders early, moved far outside and gradually weakened. ISLAND RAINBOW showed no early speed, raced extremely wide through the turn and was not a factor. MACKSIMA OCHO raced off the pacesetters from the inside and gradually weakened.
