DAYTONA raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn, reached the leaders with a furlong to run and steadily drew off. GRIMACING went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail into the lane, could not stay with the winner in the drive but finished well to save the place. HICKORY ROAD chased the leaders from the inside throughout and finished evenly. LUSTRE'S IMAGE chased the leaders from the outside and gave way through the lane. HE'S A BARN RAT showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and finished with some late run. QUITE THE MAN lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and failed to threaten. SAHARA SAM was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and gradually weakened. BIG HERO raced off the pacesetters from the inside and weakened in the drive.
