Footnotes

MAJOR MADAGAN was never far back, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter, opened a clear margin soon after and was ridden out to the wire for a convincing score. CAPTAIN BOB lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and was up for the place. TURNTABLE BAY raced wide through the first turn, dueled for the lead from the outside and gave way in the drive. CANVASBACK COVE dueled for the led from between foes for six furlongs and gave way. STELLAR BLUE was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way gradually after going a half. PETE'S BLACK GOLD lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace. HOOFPRIINTSINTIME showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not threaten. FREEDOM HALL raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened. MARVIN STEIN showed brief speed and weakened. SPICY FORMULA raced wide through the first turn, lacked early speed and was not a factor.
