Footnotes

SMART AS JIM was bumped at the start, moved up quickly to set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear margin in mid-stretch and held sway to the wire. SUESAWME hesitated at the start then was allowed to settle, raced wide through the turn, moved inside into the lane and finished with good courage. SONJA'S FIRE FLY broke sharply to press the pace from the outside throughout and finished willingly in the drive. SECRET IN SEATTLE pressed the pace from the far outside and gave way in the drive. SEATTLE SAILOR BOY was never far back, raced far wide through the turn and gradually weakened. MURPHY CREEK was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. SEETHATHARBOR raced off the pacesetters from between foes, steadied nearing the quarter and did not threaten thereafter.
