ANNIE N WILL sped clear to dictate terms, was unable to resist the winner late, but continued on willingly to prove second best. SCENT OF HEATHER settled saving ground, slipped through to make her bid entering the lane, but lacked the needed late response. TOAD YOU SO chased the pace racing between horses, but finished evenly. MARIE MARIE was pinched back at the start to get away behind her field, got through to make a mild rally, but lost all chance early. MILADY CAN FLY went evenly. RIO NEATA attended the pace racing three wide, but came up empty after a half and faded. IMPPY passed only her tiring rivals. SUMMER STRAW showed brief speed, but was through before going a half. JAZZIE JESSIE was outrun.
