BRIANVILLE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, gained command with a furlong to run and steadily drew off. GENERAL CHAOS was away alertly to press the pace from the inside, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but finished well to save the place. EXKLEMATION EL was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way in the drive. PURPLE FUZZ lagged early, moved outside through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and found his best stride late. MESABI CITY broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. SOCK PUPPET raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. PRIVATE SHADY was off slow, raced off the leaders from between foes and gradually gave way. PEACHOFAREE raced off the pacesetters from between rivals and failed to rally. THE VALID COP raced off the leaders from between foes, steadied back nearing the seven-sixteenths pole and continued to give way in the drive.
