NOBLE JEFF dueled for the lead from the outside with JIMMIE THE GROUCH throughout and proved best over that rival in the final yards. JIMMIE THE GROUCH was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside with the winner and gave way to that rival through a prolonged drive. WORKS LIKA BULLET was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders early, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with a steady rally. LES CRIME broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. MR BAQUERO was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside and lacked the needed closing response. SHOOT THE ALARM showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not menace. OURTICKETOHOME was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the outside, weakened after going three furlongs and was vanned off. WHATSINTHESOUPO lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and failed to threaten.
