ONE LITNING QWEEN was away alertly to press the pace of SARAH SWEETIE from the outside, responded to steady urging and proved best over that rival in the drive. SARAH SWEETIE went to the front soon after the start, set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear margin approaching the stretch and gave way grudgingly to the winner late. MS. LAVENDER BLUE was off slow, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy. CZARIS raced off the pacesetters from the outside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. BONNIE VAILLE chased the leaders from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. SWEET DEMAND lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. LEANNA'S BLAST was never far back while racing along the inside and gradually weakened. SWEET CHARLOTTE showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
