TWISTED WINDSOCKS was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, reached the fore with a furlong to run and quickly drew clear. DEB'S LEGACY chased the leaders from the outside throughout, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but was up for the place. MO'S FLASHY DATE was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders, moved far outside through the turn and finished with a late bid. INSPECTOR SHAMUS was bumped at the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and gave way through the final furlong. OUR TAIL WIN lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and did not threaten. LIPOMA FIR was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and failed to threaten. NOOK HAVEN chased the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened. STARDEMALION raced off the leaders from the outside and was not a factor. FORSETI'S QUESTION was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. RAPID PAT lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
