ZIGGY ZACK was never far back while racing along the inside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter, drifted out through the drive and held sway to the wire. FALL CITY FOG broke in, dueled for the lead from the inside and gave way to the winner through the lane. RHYTHM CASS raced just off the leaders from the outside and finished willingly in the drive. A LITTLE BIT LOUD was off slow, lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch and passed tiring foes late. SLOW NO MO was off slow, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. BOLD INQUISITOR pressed the pace from the outside and gave way after the opening quarter. DOTS SPARKY DANCER hopped at the start, dueled for the lead from the outside and weakened after going a half. MIGHTY TITON hopped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. MAGNETIZE was away alertly to duel for the lead from between foes, veered in nearing the eighth pole and gave way.
