Footnotes

WILD W B T was off a step slow, raced off the leaders from between foes, moved up to engage ALL STAR STAN from the inside nearing the half, opened a clear lead into the lane and held that rival at bay to the wire. ALL STAR STAN broke sharply to open a clear lead before going a quarter, raced wide while setting the pace, drifted out through the stretch and finished with good courage to hold the place. CHUPETES was away in good order then hustled along to chase the leaders from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch and finished with a steady bid. MR. BEAUTIFUL was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. DELAVEGA lagged early, raced wide through both turns and failed to menace. SMOKE THE BEAR showed brief speed from the inside and weakened. PLUM NAKED raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened. SOUTH CARSON chased the leaders from between foes and weakened after going three furlongs.
