Footnotes

LA MORUSA stalked the leaders from the inside, steadied nearing the three-eighths pole, stayed inside to offer a bid into the lane, quickly opened a clear margin and was in hand through the final sixteenth. TOUCH TOO lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. ASTRAEA DREAMS was fractious at the gate, chased the leaders from the outside throughout and failed to gain in the drive. CANADIAN SPRINGS showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. FAIR TECHNOLOGY sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened after going three-quarters. MISSKYLEEANN chased the leaders from between foes and also weakened after six furlongs.
