CONSTANTLY AGREE dueled for the lead from between foes, opened a clear margin with a furlong to run and was ridden out to the wire to increase her advantage. CLARA'S ORCHARD broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but held on well to save the place. BELLA JOURNEY raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and finished with a late bid. CROSS MY MINED was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and gave way after going a half. BORTE hopped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. MINING FOR CRYSTAL was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and did not menace. CASCADE PARK raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened. MANILA LASS was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and was not a factor.
