Footnotes

ATTA LORA was never far back while racing along the inside, moved up to take a slight advantage from ANGLES CAN BE WILD with a furlong to run and edged away from that rival through the closing yards. ANGELS CAN BE WILD was off a step slow, rushed to contend, moved up to gain command nearing the half, opened a clear margin into the lane, responded when challenged by the winner in mid-stretch but could not match strides with that rival late. PICKLED AGAIN lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, reached a contending position nearing the furlong marker but failed to gain late. ROXY SKYLAR chased the leaders from between foes throughout and lacked the needed closing response. LOW EXPECTATIONS sprinted clear at once, raced wide while setting the pace and weakened after going three-quarters. PEPE LE FEU was off a step slow, lagged early and did not reach contention. A. LURIE GIRL raced wide through both turns and gradually weakened.
