EPIC TALE settled saving ground, angled out to make his bid, and was fully extended to wear down his rivals in the final yards. INDYSHOTSHOT stalked the pace racing along the inside, got through to launch his bid, forged a narrow lead with a furlong to run, continued on willingly but was unable to resist the winner. AGENT GREY sped clear to set the pace, weakened slightly from between horses during the drive, but had enough left to just hold the show. SLEWDLEDO WAY was allowed to settle into stride, got through to make his rally, but found his best stride too late. BEAU SLEW was slow into stride, made a mild rally from between horses, but failed to seriously threaten. SOUND PROSPECT stalked the pace racing three wide, was carried out through the turn, and lacked a response when called upon. REVIVAL SITE chased the pace racing along the inside, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. TRUE FAITH failed to respond. D DEVIL showed little.
