Footnotes

HE'S A GOLDEN BOY went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail into the lane and steadily drew off. ICECOLA chased the leaders from the outside, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to hold the place. SUMBAS ROCKET was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside and finished evenly in the drive. PIONEER GUSTO raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and also finished evenly. PURPLE FUZZ was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground throughout the turn angled out and was bumped nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with some late run. OBIEJOHN was never far back, saved ground throughout and gradually gave way. THE VALID COP lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. I AM THE POWER raced off the leaders from the outside and was not a factor. CHEHALEM PROSPECT was void of early speed, raced off the rail through the turn, was bumped nearing the three-sixteenth pole and not urged thereafter. RONTHEROADAGAIN was off slow, raced far back and was eased after the opening quarter.
