JAMESON KID was allowed to settle into stride, ranged into striking distance through the turn, angled out into the lane, reeled in TANYA'S TOAD and quickly drew clear. TANYA'S TOAD set the pressured pace racing two wide, was no match for the winner, but continued on willingly to clearly prove second best. KNIGHTS CHALLENGE pressed the pace racing along the inside, weakened during the drive, then was all out to just hold the show. GO AMERICA was slow into stride, came four wide to make a mild rally, but failed to seriously threaten. DR. DANIEL was hustled along racing three wide, offered a mild bid leaving the turn, but failed to sustain the drive. AT THE BAR passed only his tiring rivals. VALANTEA was hustled along racing between horses, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. REALLY UNIQUE chased the pace racing three wide for a half and stopped.
