### Footnotes

BLEU TARP sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace and drew off through the lane as a handy winner. CHET THE JET was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out in mid-stretch, was no match for the winner in the drive but held on to save the place. COREYTHENAVIGATOR lacked early speed, angled out nearing the quarter, came back inside nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good energy. FRESH MANGOLD chased the leaders from the outside for a half and gave way. GEARING UP was away alertly then dropped off the leaders, moved outside through the turn and failed to rally. THUNDER THORN showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
