MOJOSLEW stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-eighths marker, opened a clear lead in mid-stretch and held sway to the wire. COURAGEOUS COMMAND was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with good energy. BUSTER WITH A K was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, gave way to the winner in the drive but finished with good courage. LOWER TOWN LAD was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. WHATSINTHESOUP bumped at the start, pressed the pace from between foes, steadied nearing the nine-sixteenths pole and continued to give way thereafter. The rider of WHATSINTHESOUP lodged an objection against MOJOSLEW concerning the steadying of his mount at the nine-sixteenths pole and after reviewing the films the stewards made no change.
