Footnotes

LACK OF MONEY stalked the pace along the inside, closed steadily when put to pressure nearing the five-sixteenths pole, angled out entering the lane to find room, slipped through and wore down her rivals under stern urging in the final furlong. BRUSH STROKES sped clear to set the early pace, held fairly well during the drive, but was unable to resist the winner in the final yards. MISS LOVE SOMEONE made a belated rally leaving the bend, split rivals with a furlong to run, finished willingly but found her best stride too late. K C'S PEGGY chased the pace along the inside, but weakened slightly during the drive and faded late. TATTERDEMALION was hustled along racing four wide in mid pack, and went evenly. SHESADREAM failed to respond. CROWNING RUBY pressed the pace racing three wide, but was used up after a half and dropped out. SPRING FANTASY was hustled along to attend the early pace, but came up empty on the turn and stopped. SPEEDERHOF got away a step slow, never recovered, and was always outrun.
