WHATSINTHESOUPT pressed the pace from the outside, dropped back nearing the quarter, moved up to take command nearing the eighth pole and held off STOP LAUGHING to prevail. STOP LAUGHING raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. TIZ I IS broke sharply to press the pace from between foes and gave way in the drive. CHROMETASTIC dueled for the lead from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. AMPHITRITES GIFT pressed the pace from the outside and gradually gave way. TIMBER TWISTER lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and did not reach contention. FAST LIGHTNIN was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. FREE TO GO showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
