WARREN'S PLAYER pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to engage STEPS OF WRATH nearing the quarter and got the nod over that rival though a prolonged drive. STEPS OF WRATH was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when engaged by the winner nearing the quarter and just missed in a game effort. ICWHATYOURLOOKINAT showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with some late run. NATURE TRAIL was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and lacked the needed closing response. LADY VITESSE chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going six furlongs. FOXY LIKE A CAT lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not threaten. KNOWN AS LU broke sharply to press the pace from between foes and weakened after going three-quarters.
