WENT SOUTH stalked the pace, rallied from four wide at the quarter pole to steadily advance and get up in the final strides. TWILIGHT CHANCE rushed up to set a clear pace at once but could not hold off the late closer, and just missed. MARY'S DELIGHT stalked the pace, was hustled along in the turn, but flattened out in the stretch. SHE'S THE BOSS was unhurried early, got hustled in mid turn from six wide, and posted a late gain. TATTERDEMALION made a mild rally passing the three-eighths pole but proved no threat. MISS FINE GOLD pressed the early pace until fading in the last quarter. J. T.'S LOVE raced evenly and never threatened. SAWTOOTH MOUNTAIN was pinched back at the start and checked, slowly recovered to hustle six wide, but was no threat. SWEETPEA SEA put out a dull effort. NATALIES HOPE was pinched back at the start, hustled up to stalk the pace until tiring entering the stretch. STILL WAITING made a steady fade. RAPID POWER flashed brief speed, then gave way.
