Footnotes

NEW MEXICO KID stalked the pace of RAY'S RENO from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, responded to steady urging and wore that rival down through the final yards. RAY'S RENO was away in good order to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear margin nearing the five-sixteenths pole but could not resist the winner in the drive. OLYMPIC LIGHTS chased the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. MR MAHAL raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. JUSTBROWN was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to threaten. BLOOD AND DIAMOND pressed the pace from the outside for three furlongs and weakened. NEWAUKUM CREEK showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. SHAKIN SHAMUS was void of early foot, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor.
