WABI SABI was hustled along to attend the pace racing between horses, came three wide into the lane, finished willingly and was gaining late. UNIQUE HONOR was away alertly, then settled saving ground, got through to make his rally, but found his best stride too late. LUNAR CONSOLATION chased the pace racing three wide, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. CHUZZ was unhurried early, angled in to save ground, finished with a belated rally, but was never a factor. JOEAUSTIN showed little. PISTOL PAKIN PETE broke slowly and never recovered.
