DEPUTY ALLSTAR was never far back, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter, reached the fore with a furlong to run and drew clear through the final yards. CHET THE JET showed no early speed, angled far outside nearing the quarter and finished with good energy to be up for the place. COLONEL COURTNEY was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from between foes, angled out into the lane and finished willingly. SEA OF FOG went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail while setting the pace, responded when challenged approaching the stretch and gave way through the final furlong. HE'S A GOBLIN was off slow and bumped, rushed to contend, chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going a half. VICKYS FAST BOY lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace.
